

STANDARDISED PRICE LIST – Northwood and Sons. May 2025.

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)	£3542.00
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements.	£1816.00
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care.	£ 250.00
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's branch premises.	£ 420.00
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from veneered oak and suitable lined/upholstered.	£ 549.00
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer).	£ 60.00
At a date and time, you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle.	£ 447.00
UNATTENDED FUNERAL	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£1700.00
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee) ²	£1875.00
FEES YOU MUST PAY	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee . ¹	
In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:	£ 872.00

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.

Invoice Terms

- We do not require a deposit before the funeral takes place, however if the third-party costs (disbursements) are paid in advance (as a deposit) then there may be a reduction in costs.
- The funeral account is due for payment within fourteen days of our account, unless otherwise agreed by us in writing.
- If you fail to pay us in full on the due date we may charge you interest:
 - At a rate of 5% above our Banks Base rate from time to time in force
 - Calculated (on a daily basis) from the date of our account until payment in full;
 - Compounded on the first day of each month; and
 - Before and after any judgement (unless a Court orders otherwise).
 - We may recover the cost of taking legal action to make you pay.
